Dr. Norman is the Director of the Pocono Lake Ecological Observatory Network (PLEON). Volunteers of the Twin and Walker Creeks Watershed Conservancy collect water samples and with a probe, take a number of measurements that are sent to PLEON. Beth Norman is the Director of Science and Research at Lacawac Sanctuary. She is an ecosystem ecologist who has been studying Appalachian freshwaters for over 15 years. Dr. Norman is also the Director of the Pocono Lake Ecological Observatory Network, or PLEON, a lake monitoring, education, and citizen science program that helps lake communities in the Poconos care for their lakes. She will be discussing water quality trends in Twin and Walker Lakes.
